Notes about services

Services are normally held on the 2nd, 4th and 5th Sunday at 11.30 am, and on the preceding Saturday at 6.00 pm, of every month. In addition, an evening Festal Vespertal Liturgy is normally celebrated at 6.30 pm on the eve of the Great Feasts when these occur on a weekday. Special mid-week services are also celebrated during Great Lent and throughout Holy Week. All services are celebrated in English, with some prayers in Church Slavonic, Greek, Romanian and French. There is normally an opportunity for people to make their confession after every evening service or before the Liturgy on Sundays, and by arrangement at other times during the week.

About the parish

The parish belongs to the worldwide Orthodox Church, being part of the Deanery within the Archdiocese of Thyateira and Great Britain of the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople. Our sister parish in London, dedicated to the Feast of the Dormition of the Mother of God, also holds services in Central London (www.dormition.org.uk). Our local members represent a diversity of languages and cultures including American, Australian, British, Bulgarian, Canadian, Cypriot, Dutch, Finnish, French, Georgian, German, Greek, Irish, Japanese, Lebanese, Lithuanian, New Zealand, Polish, Romanian, Russian, Serbian, South African and Ukrainian. Members of all Christian and other faith communities are most welcome to attend our services and everyone is encouraged to bring and share light refreshments (finger food) after the Sunday Liturgy.
